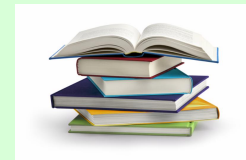
FACEBOOKERS ALERT!!!! (No ... we have not been hacked.) We need to help each other make this upcoming concert (see above) a success for OUC.

Broadview

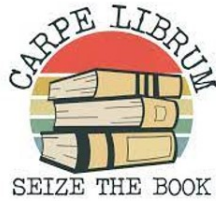
Broadview subscription renewal time is upon us. The price is \$25 for the year, beginning in September. That is excellent value if you compare similar

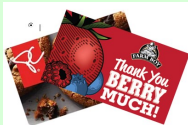
