Update: Search for New Minister

Progress is being made on the search for a new minister.

- The Eastern Ontario Outaouais Region has appointed Rev. Laurie McKnight to be the Pastoral Relations Liaison person to guide the work of OUC's Search Team. Rev. McKnight is the former minister of St. Paul's Eastern United Church and she has some familiarity with OUC as a consequence of her involvement with a number of the online worship services (a.k.a. Virtch) during the pandemic in partnership with Carleton Memorial, McKay, OUC, Queenswood, and Rothwell United churches.
- The **Search Team will be having a kick-off meeting very soon** to review the processes and procedures involved in carrying out their work. Rev. McKnight and Peter Holt (past Chair of Ministry & Personnel) will facilitate this discussion.
- Finally, I am happy to report that **several candidates have already submitted applications** for OUC's opening via the United Church of Canada ChurchHub.

Please hold the Search Team in your thoughts and prayers, and grant them your trust, as they embark on the important work that they will be doing on our behalf. It is essential that we respect the confidential nature of this work and refrain from prying for details.

May is Mental Health month, so this month's Helpful hints are about supporting, caring for and being present for someone who is struggling with their mental health.

Mental health illness is not a choice, showing compassion is! If you know someone who is struggling with their mental health there are a number of ways you can show compassion.

- Reach out to them, with a note, a card, or a text, without any expectations of hearing back.
- Continue to show you care even when it's not reciprocated.
- Let them know they are not alone...even in the darkness.
- Listen without judgement, solutions or suggestions.
- Validate their challenge, as you would if someone was struggling with a physical health issue.
- Let them know they are valued and cared for.

We can you expect on this day – besides great food?

- · Feel a sense of wider appreciation
- · Be seen in the midst of your own commitment to the well-being of others
- Feel understood amid your personal questions and/or experiences


